## **PROVIDER ACCESS POLICY**

### **1. Introduction**

This policy sets out the arrangements for managing access of providers to learners at Health Futures UTC for the purpose of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. This complies with the UTC's legal obligations under the Technical and Further Education Act 2017.

### **2. Learner entitlement**

All learners in years 10 to 13 are entitled to:

- Find out about technical qualifications and apprenticeship opportunities, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options at each transition point;
- Hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships, through options events, assemblies and group discussions and taster events;
- Understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.

### **3. Provider access requests**

3.1 Providers are given access to students and/or their parents, with reasonable notice, and will be given the opportunity to talk to small groups of students who are interested in their offer.

3.2 Requests are managed by the specialist subject lead who will organise an appropriate venue. We will also make available AV and any other specialist equipment to support provider presentations. This will be discussed and agreed in advance of the visit.

3.3 Providers are able to leave a copy of their prospectus or other relevant literature in the Learning Resource Centre.

3.3 Providers may also request a stand at the annual careers fair if they have not already been invited.

#### **4. Monitoring Evaluation and Review of Policy**

The Principal will report to the Governors relevant aspects of the working of the policy as appropriate.

The governing body reviews this policy every two years.
