#### Welcome to Shireland Biomedical UTC Sixth Form



Our Give Back initiative enables students to volunteer and support the academy community. Opportunities include helping as lunchtime supervisors, running clubs, supporting in lessons, or assisting at reception. Students are encouraged to seek volunteering placements with external organisations such as local pharmacies or healthcare centres, developing employability skills and a strong sense of community.

#### **UCAS & Careers Support**

We begin the UCAS process early in Year 12 to give students the best possible start for their post-18 pathways. Every student receives one-to-one careers guidance and ongoing support with applications, personal statements, CVs, and interview preparation. Whether aiming for university, a gap year, apprenticeship or employment, students are supported every step of the way.

- High-quality facilities with regular visits to BCU's City South Campus for immersive clinical simulation training.






# Support, Bursaries & How to Apply
